1	[PROPOSED] ORDER		
2	On February 28, 2025, a hearing was held on Plaintiffs Kimberly Pelletier and Jason		
3	Johnson's ("Plaintiffs") Motion for Final Approval of the Class Settlement (the "Settlement")		
4	between Plaintiffs and Defendant ABC LEGAL SERVICES, LLC ("Defendant").		
5	The parties have submitted the Settlement, which this Court preliminarily approved by its		
6	Amended Order entered on September 5, 2024 (the "Preliminary Approval Order"). In accordance		
7	with the Preliminary Approval Order, Class Members have been given notice of the terms of the		
8	Settlement and the opportunity to object to it or to exclude themselves from its provisions.		
9	Having received and considered the Settlement, the supporting papers filed by the parties, and		
10	the evidence and argument received by the Court at the hearing before it entered the Preliminary		
11	Approval Order and at the final approval hearing on February 28, 2025, the Court grants final		
12	approval of the Settlement, and HEREBY ORDERS, ADJUDGES, and DECREES as follows:		
13	1. Pursuant to the Preliminary Approval Order, the Class Notice was sent to each Class		
14	Member by first-class mail. The Court finds and determines that this notice procedure afforded		
15	adequate protections to Class Members and provides the basis for the Court to make an informed		
16	decision regarding approval of the Settlement based on the responses of Class Members. The Court		
17	finds and determines that the notice provided in this case was the best notice practicable, which		
18	satisfied the requirements of law and due process.		
19	2. The Court finds and determines that the Class, as conditionally certified by the		
20	Preliminary Approval Order, meets all of the legal requirements for class certification for settlement		
21	purposes only under Code of Civil Procedure section 382, and it is hereby ordered that the Class is		
22	finally certified for settlement purposes.		
23	3. The Court further finds and determines that the terms of the Settlement are fair,		
24	reasonable, and adequate to the Class and to each Class Member, and that the Class Members who did		
25	not timely submit valid Requests for Exclusion in accordance with the Settlement Agreement and the		
26	Preliminary Approval Order will be bound by the Settlement, that the Settlement is ordered finally		
27	approved, and that all terms and provisions of the Settlement should be and hereby are ordered to be		
28	consummated.		

[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR FINAL APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

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1	4.	Without affecting the finality of this order in any way, the Court retains jurisdiction of
2	all matters rela	ting to the interpretation, administration, implementation, effectuation and enforcement
3	of this order ar	nd the Settlement.

- 5. Nothing in this Order will preclude any action to enforce the parties' obligations under
 the Settlement or under this Order, including the requirement that Defendant make payments to the
 Class Members in accordance with the Settlement.
- 7 6. Upon completion of administration of the Settlement, the Settlement Administrator
 8 will provide written certification of such completion to the Court and counsel for the parties.
- 9 7. The parties are hereby ordered to comply with the terms of the Settlement.
- 8. The Court hereby enters final judgment in accordance with the terms of the Settlement
 (attached as Exhibit 4 to the Declaration of Shaun Markley, submitting in Support of Plaintiff's
 Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement filed on June 24, 2024), Preliminary
 Approval Order entered on September 5, 2024, and this Order.
- 9. Pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 3.769, the Court hereby directs that the
 Clerk of the Court enter the Court's Order as a Final Judgment.
- 16 10. The Parties will bear their own costs and attorneys' fees except as provided herein.
 17 11. The Court finds that Plaintiffs request for \$474,952.50 in fees (one-third of the

settlement fund) and \$20,000.00 in costs is reasonable. Therefore, the Court orders \$494,952.50 to be
paid to Plaintiffs' Counsel.

- 20 12. The Settlement Administrator is awarded \$23,000.00 to be paid from the settlement
 21 fund.
- 13. The Court finds that Plaintiffs requested service award of \$10,000.00 each, for a total
 of \$20,000.00 is approved, and orders that it be paid from the settlement fund.

A status conference is set for July 25, 2025, at 9:15 a.m., to confirm the completion of 14. the settlement process and disbursement of the settlement proceeds.
