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This Court, having granted final approval of the Amended Joint Stipulation and Settlement agreement between Plaintiffs and Defendants (the "Stipulation") in the above-entitled action, as set forth in the Court's Order (1) Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, and (2) Entering Judgment ("Final Approval Order"),

HEREBY ORDERS, ADJUDGES AND DECREES that Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Court's Final Approval Order and the Parties' Stipulation as follows and hereby directs the Agreement be consummated in accordance with its terms and conditions, including the following:

- A. The Court orders the settlement payment in the amount of \$156,000.00 as stipulated in the parties signed settlement agreement.
- The court orders and determines that the \$20,000.00, to be paid to the Class Administrator from the settlement amount for all of its agreed work done, and to be done until the completion of this matter, is appropriate.
- C. Plaintiffs, Albertina Torres and Yolanda Castillo, are hereby approved as Class Representatives and is hereby approved to receive an incentive award in the sum of \$7,500 to Plaintiff Albertina Torres and \$7,500.00 to Plaintiff Yolanda Castillo, with no deductions. The Claims Administrator shall make such payment pursuant to section 4.3 of the Class Action Settlement Agreement.
- D. Attorneys' fees in the amount of \$52,000.00 to the Law Offices of Hugo Gamez ("Class Counsel") is approved for all work performed and to be performed until the completion of this matter. Class Administrator is ordered to pay said attorneys' fees from the settlement amount to Class Counsel pursuant to section 4.3 of the Class Action Settlement Agreement.

  Costs for Class Counsel are affected in the amount of 713, 500.

  E. Payment of \$5,000.00 to the State of California Labor and Workforce Development

Agency ("LWDA") for civil penalties pursuant to the California Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act is approved. The Class Administrator is ordered to make payments from the GFV as follows: (1) \$1,250.00 of the PAGA penalties (which represents 25% of the amount allocated to PAGA penalties) will be paid to Participating Class Members (i.e., those Class Members who do not opt out of the settlement); and (2) the remaining \$3,750.00 of the PAGA penalties (which represents

75% of the amount allocated to PAGA penalties) will be paid to the LWDA and will make said payment within 7 business days of the Final Approval.

- F. The court retains continuing jurisdiction as to all matters relating to the administration and consummation of the settlement as provide in the Stipulation and all other matters covered in this Order.
- G. Any future matters by Class Members against Releases Parties for claims alleged in this matter are barred (As defined in the Stipulation of Settlement) for any Released Claims from the period of July 27, 2018 through June 10, 2024. To the extent any Class Members fail to cash settlement checks after distribution has taken place, the Settlement Administrator shall file a report pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 384, concerning the amount of money to the California Controller's Unclaimed Property Fund no later than 25 days

of the chief cashing period follower
