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JUDGMENT


Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Order Granting Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs, and a Class Representative Enhancement Payment.

Five percent of Class Counsel's fee award, or \$12,916.65, is to be kept in an interest-bearing account established by the Settlement Administrator until the completion of the distribution process and Court approval of a final accounting. Plaintiff shall file and serve a report/declaration summarizing all distributions made pursuant to the approved Settlement on or before August 1, 2025. The Court sets an OSC re Compliance with the terms of the Settlement for August 21, 2025 at 9:00 a.m.

Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all Participating Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein. This document shall constitute a judgment (and separate document constituting said judgment) for purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h).
